The Muggles of Year 5 go to Hogwarts!



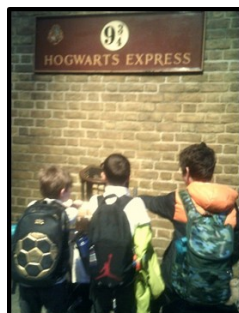

Month of the Military Child

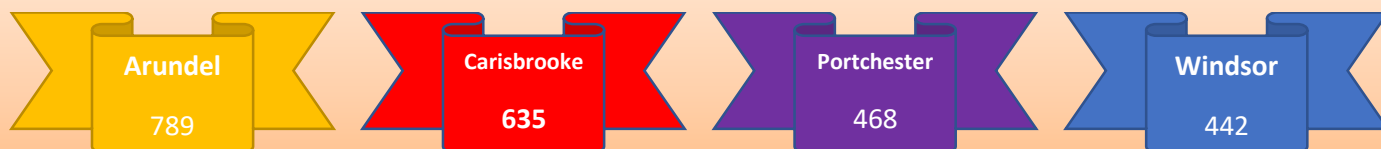

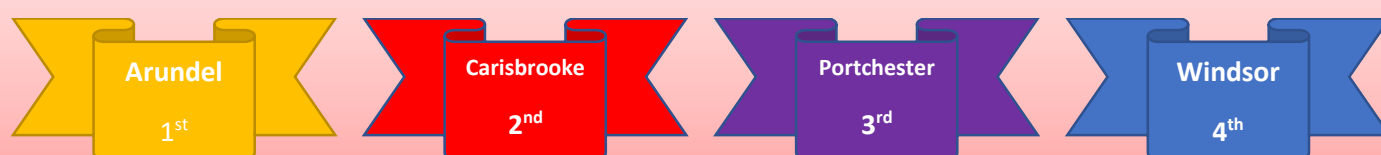
