

Road safety

At Kings Worthy Primary, we believe it is important to reinforce the message about road safety whether we are walking, cycling, scootering or as a car passenger.

The following graph shows Hampshire's child casualties for 2022.



199 children between the ages of 0-15 years were either injured or seriously injured on Hampshire roads!! We have signed up for 2 interactive road safety sessions provided by the Hampshire Road Safety Team. These will be held in June for Years 2 and 5. These interactive sessions last between 30-45 minutes. They encourage discussions about road safety and allow children to complete activities which reinforce the importance of being safe by the road.

We will also be running a poster competition, organised by the Hampshire Road Safety Team. More details will be provided to the children soon!!!


