Vacancies

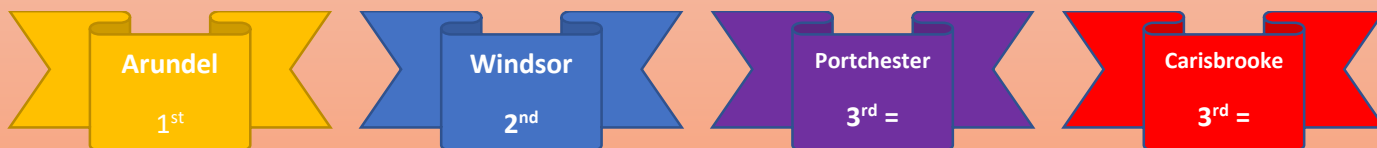
